## GESTOSIS - INDEX (GI) Modification Hamdi El Kabarity . Cairo / Egypt

This modification is based on the original Gestosis Index by Goecke However it sets other priorities and includes a more detailed list of therapeutic possibilities.

Since EPH - Gestosis is a syndrome and not one disease the effect of the signs and symptoms on the fetus and the mother may vary greatly according to the location of the pregnant woman. i.e. cases of EPH - Gestosis in Central Africa, in rural India and in he middle of Europe require special attention focused on the its specific needs.
