National medical library was found by Caucasus medical society in 1864. This is the oldest and largest library of the medical literature in Georgia, annalist of the history of Georgian medicine.

The book fund of library consists of almost 700 000 units. There are kept the oldest and rarest handwritten books, old complects of the leading medical journals, unique bibliographic publications.

The library does bibliographical and informational jobs. It has published fundamental bibliographical book of references "Georgian Medicine in 1921-1947". The next volumes are ready to publish. Different bibliographical bulletins are published and also are ready to publish.

The library has different catalogues and card indexes unique with its contents, electronic data bases. It's still been filling the books funds as with Georgian books as foreign literature.

Many estimable representatives of the medical society were grown here and improved the qualifications-scientists, doctors and others.

The library is one of the founders of the associations of Georgian libraries' automatization and young specialists of libraries.
